## Application Fees

A new Patient will pay an initial fee, speak to the doctor, then obtain a temporary card from the Cannabis Control Commission (CCC). Existing Patients will have an appointment with B & B within seven (7) days of their medical marijuana card's expiration date.

## Scheduling Procedure

Patients must renew their card annually. Your medical card will always have the same month and day as the expiration date. Although you won't get in trouble for renewing your card late (other than not being a valid patient for a length of time), you will get less than a year's worth out of your card. To avoid that and to ensure that you get a full year out of your medical card, B & B will set up a yearly appointment with you.

**Ex:** Initial appointment was on: 08/10/20

Card expires on: 08/11/21

Next appointment between: 08/01/21-08/10/21

## Follow-up Appointments

B & B shall email each patient six (6) months after their appointment with a follow-up inquiry in order to maintain an ongoing relationship, and to monitor the effectiveness of medical marijuana for patients. This follow-up survey is optional, but encouraged. Patients will not be charged for this follow-up inquiry.
