## State Reciprocity Status

### Alaska

Reciprocal: No

Legal Purchasing: It is legal to purchase up to 1 ounce of cannabis for recreational purposes

### Arizona

Reciprocal: Limited to “visiting qualifying patients” The cardholder must match the qualifying condition between Arizona and their home state. So, if your qualifying condition in your home state doesn’t match Arizona’s, you cannot technically qualify for Arizona’s MMJ card program.

Legal Purchasing: Recreational cannabis is legal to purchase in Arizona, with a possession limit of up to 2.5 ounces.

### Arkansas

Reciprocal: Yes, you can legally purchase medical marijuana in Arkansas, provided you fill out a visiting patient form and can provide proof of out-of-state medical marijuana registration.

Legal Purchasing: Only Medical

### California

Reciprocal: NO, California doesn’t recognize out-of-state medical marijuana cards

Legal Purchasing: Recreational cannabis is legal in California, with a possession limit of up to 1 oz., or 8 grams of concentrate.

### Colorado

Reciprocal: No

Legal Purchasing: Recreational cannabis is legal in Colorado, with a possession limit of 1 ounce.

## **Illinois**

Reciprocal: No

Legal Purchasing: Yes, recreationally legal.

## **Hawaii**

Reciprocal: NO, but you can apply for a card within their state, even if you don't live there

Legal Purchasing: NO

## **Maine**

Reciprocal: Yes, but patients must register with the Maine MMJ program in order to access dispensaries. When out-of-state patients register, they have a temporary registration that allows them to legally purchase cannabis from a dispensary. The possession limit is 2.5 ounces.

Legal Purchasing: Yes, recreationally legal

## **Michigan**

Reciprocal: Yes, Michigan's dispensaries can choose whether or not they will recognize an out-of-state medical marijuana

Legal Purchasing: Yes, recreationally legal

## **Minnesota**

Reciprocal: No

Legal Purchasing: No

## **Mississippi**

Reciprocal: There are no laws regarding medical marijuana reciprocity established in Mississippi as of yet.

Legal Purchasing: No

## **Missouri**

Reciprocal: The law is unclear

Legal Purchasing: No

## **Montana**

Reciprocal: Yes, dispensaries will check to see if your qualification is valid, that you have a medical marijuana card, and your state ID.

Legal Purchasing: Yes, recreationally legal

## **Nevada**

Reciprocal: Yes

Legal Purchasing: Yes, recreationally legal

## **New Hampshire**

Reciprocal: Limited, If the qualifying condition for your medical marijuana card from your home state matches New Hampshire's qualifying condition, then New Hampshire will recognize your medical marijuana card. Out-of-state patients may not service New Hampshire dispensaries, but may legally possess medical marijuana if they have entered the state with it.

Legal Purchasing: No

## **New Jersey**

Reciprocal: Yes, individuals who are registered as patients under their states' medical marijuana programs can receive reciprocity, or otherwise be considered to be qualifying patients, under New Jersey's medical marijuana program for up to six months while they are visiting the state.

Legal Purchasing: Yes

## **New York**

Reciprocal: No

Legal Purchasing: Yes, but laws may be rolled back

## **Ohio**

Reciprocal: No

Legal Purchasing: No

## **Oklahoma**

Reciprocal: Yes, however, visiting patients must fill out the Temporary Patient Application Information form in order to legally purchase medical marijuana from an Oklahoma dispensary.

Legal Purchasing: No

## **Oregon**

Reciprocal: No

Legal Purchasing: Yes, recreationally legal

## **Pennsylvania**

Reciprocal: No

Legal Purchasing: No

## **Puerto Rico**

Reciprocal: Yes, Puerto Rico recognizes other states' medical marijuana cards, and card holders can purchase from a dispensary legally.

Legal Purchasing: No, Recreational cannabis is not legal in Puerto Rico.

## **Rhode Island**

Reciprocal: Yes

Legal Purchasing: No, Recreational cannabis is not legal in Rhode Island

## **Vermont**

Reciprocal: No

Legal Purchasing: Yes, recreationally legal

## **Utah**

Reciprocal: Yes, visiting medical marijuana patients who meet one of Utah's qualifying conditions may possess and use medical cannabis in accordance with Utah's legal restrictions.

Legal Purchasing: No

## **Virginia**

Reciprocal: No

Legal Purchasing: Yes, recreationally legal

## **Washington**

Reciprocal: No

Legal Purchasing: Yes, recreationally legal

## **Washington, D.C.**

Reciprocal: Yes

Legal Purchasing: Yes, recreationally legal
